Home visit reward

Pregnant members who complete an in-home visit from a participating maternal program, can receive a \$50 reward*.

Babyscripts

Free access to maternal and baby health mobile app. Up to \$75 in Walmart e-gift cards.



Extra help for HCBS waiver members**

Over-the-counter assistance

All LTSS members receive a \$50 reward on reloadable OTC Network® card*.

Pest control

HCBS members who own their home are eligible for one pest control treatment (up to \$250 annually).

Bike helmets

Members up to 18 years old can receive a bike helmet valued at \$50 every year.

Air purifier

Members up to 18 years old with an asthma diagnosis can receive an air purifier valued at \$75 per year.

Weighted blankets

Members on the Autism or SED waivers can receive a weighted blanket to provide support for anxiety. Foster Care members also eligible.

Calendar

All waiver members receive a 2025 wellness calendar in the mail.
